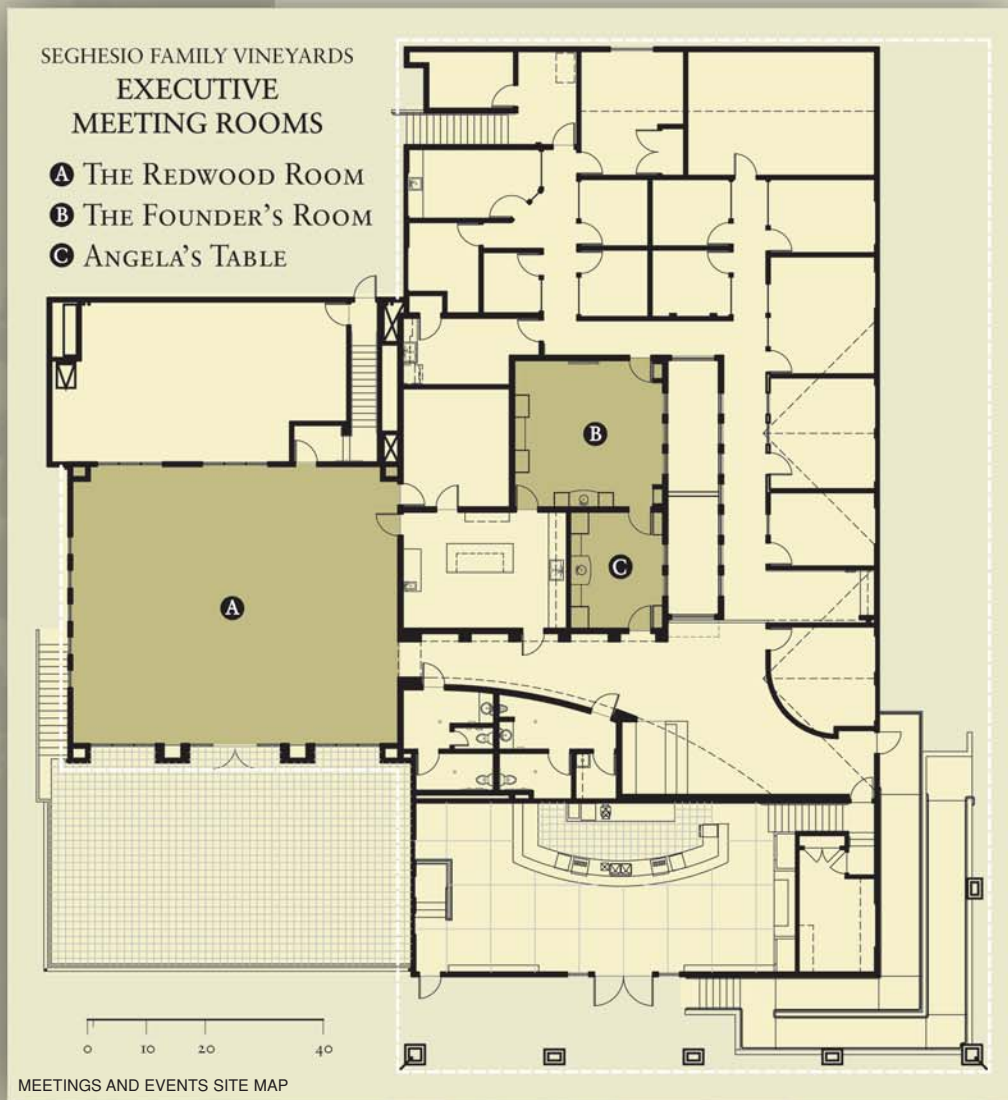


Uncommon Events

Angelá's Table CAPACITY: 8

The beautiful table accommodates 8 or fewer guests for private dining, tastings or small business meetings with guests seated among the Seghesio family's collection of library vintages.
